



Holy Joe Edgar Wille

When I was a child, my father used to hold services in our house. One day someone had scrawled graffiti on the footpath leading to our home. It read: 'Holy Joe'!

To be committed to a religious faith got you seen as someone very 'picky' about what was good and what was bad. And if there was a God insisting on these standards, He couldn't be very nice. 'Holy' is a description that most people would not be happy with. It suggests looking down on other less fussy people who get on with enjoying their lives. However, in the Bible, the writer of the Letter to the Hebrews has God saying: 'Be ye holy for I am holy'.

Christians ought to be holy! What does that mean? The work 'holy' means being set apart for special purposes, separated from the way most people go about life, heedless of God. The above writer also says that: 'Without holiness no one shall see God', meaning that they don't perceive what God and Jesus are like, and don't try to behave like them. Those who follow the

Christian way should show love and kindness to their fellow humans, looking for the best in them and not stabbing them in the back with angry, hostile words and deeds. They should seek to help people who are in trouble, and certainly not despise those who live in poverty and experience other misfortunes.

This involves avoiding the practises of what the Bible calls 'the world', to which TV and the press give daily witness. The Apostle James feels strongly about this, saying: 'He who makes himself the friend of the world is at enmity with God'. A 'friend of God' will abstain from the self-seeking and pleasure dominated activities which rule many of people's waking hours. In fact, to live in God's way brings more real pleasure than living with little thought of God and Jesus. Bible writers often call this 'a new life', with new hopes of a friendship with God and unimaginable joys in a future age where the secret of love will prevail.

Three Hours Hard Labour

That's what bellringers volunteer for when they attempt to ring a peal. Alan, Chris, David, Kate, Ken, Maurice, Steve and Valerie (not me!) came from as far as Cholsey, Guildford, Wheatley and Wokingham, and from as near as Amersham, Hemel Hempstead and Berkhamsted to Northchurch on 16th February – just for the fun of ringing the bells at St Mary's.

I heard a 'wobbly bit' as I listened in the church. I wondered if all was well when the bells were still ringing as the clock ticked past 2 hours 53 minutes. (That's the usual time it takes to ring a peal on our bells.) After 3 hours, I heard the bells come into rounds, the 'pattern' of sound in which bells traditionally start and finish anything they ring. Oh dear! The words "It wasn't successful" greeted me as I joined the ringers in the ringing room.


That's when my admiration for those who conduct ringing went up a notch. Alan had realised that two of the bells had changed places - shall we say a little independently of what was expected of them! He could

have said "Stand" (bellspeak for Stop) but he decided to keep going. He worked out when to call 'Bob' so that the erring bells would swap back into their proper places and the ringing would be able to end tidily in rounds. There was no chance for Alan to pause, scribble on a bit of paper, or consult his Smartphone. He made his calculations while continuing to ring his own bell, keeping his place in the pattern of the method!

There wasn't the usual sense of achievement for the band as they left the church – but they took solace in crossing the road to the *George & Dragon*.

You might be a little critical that I said this ringing was for fun. But it's worth noting that these ringers are also committed to ring regularly for Sunday services, giving of their best in the service of the church. Two of them ring at St Paul's and Guildford Cathedrals – and one of them is also a Professor of Divinity.






